Friday, August 26th

- 9:00 AM** Arrive at the Bannock County Fairgrounds Main Arena in Pocatello, ID (One Hour Prior to Competition)
- 9:45 AM** Contestants Meeting.
- 10:00 AM** Horsemanship: Bannock County Fairgrounds, patterns are attached.
(Note: Patterns are different for Sr. Queen, Teen Queen, Jr. Queen, & Pee Wee Queen)
Attire: Western Shirt (Entirely White), Western Jeans (Any Color), Hat, Boots, Belt, and Accessories (No Gloves or Chaps) (Scarves or bow ties may be added, any color)
- Enter the arena on horseback dismount in front of judges, give a 2-3 minute speech (PeeWee’s one minute) and answer questions from the judges. Speech title: **“What is special and unique about the rodeo you represent.”** After speech and questions mount and perform your horsemanship pattern.
- 2:30-3:30 PM** Portnief Medical visiting the Pediatric Ward
- 4:00PM** Arrive at Bannock County Fairgrounds Main Arena in Pocatello, ID.
- 4:30PM** Freestyle Reining Competition contestants will receive 25 bonus points.
- 7:00 PM** Rodeo Performance: Bannock County Fairgrounds Main Arena (Remember Flag Boot)
Grand Entry Attire: Show Apparel. Reining Queens and contestants are **required** to pack flags on their horses. Stay throughout the rodeo, sign autographs and mingle with the public. (Contestants are **required** to assist in arena with cattle) Pee Wee Queens are excluded from the arena help. They can assist if they want to.

Saturday, August 27th

- 10:00 AM – 12:00 PM** Autograph party at Vicker’s Western Wear in Pocatello, Idaho.
- 1:00 PM** Luncheon at Perkins.
- 4:00 PM** Arrive at the Bannock County Fairgrounds Main Arena (To be ready for Coronation)
- 4:30 PM** Coronation: Pre-Rodeo Entertainment. Mandatory the Contestants stay for the Grand Entry, if you leave before Grand Entry than you **forfeit** your prizes.
- 7:00 PM** Rodeo Performance: Bannock County Fairgrounds Main Arena (Remember Flag Boot)
